GRAND KNIGHT'S MESSAGE

Dear Knights and Families,

The State Convention was great this year. Mike and I attended. We have elected a new State Deputy with the torch passing from Mike Laake to Joe Ramirez, former State Secretary. Lou Barbour, Director of Fraternal Services, joined us from Supreme. Council 5390 was awarded with John and Mary Kaufmann as The Iowa Family of the Year Award and the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Playground Project as The Roundtable Award of the Year Award. I was told that the Joplin Missouri project was next in line for the Community Project Award. We out-collected all councils on PID and out-gave on Pennies from Heaven. Bishop R. Walker Nicklass presided at our Sunday Mass and made reference to the Divine Mercy Sunday (first Sunday after Easter). We finished the conference with Benediction and the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Mike and I stopped by Trinity Heights to see the 30 foot statues of Mary and Jesus before we returned from this pilgrimage. When you think you have to go outside of Iowa for summer vacation, do not forget this spot as well as the Grotto of the Redemption in West Bend as pilgrimages.

Health and Human Services (HHS) is the number one issue facing Catholics. I will give a synopsis of "events" leading to the present conscience protection debate stemming from contraception, sterilization and abortion:

1930	Anglican Church allows contraception – first Christian church to allow an exception
1960	The Contraceptive Pill FDA approval (Enovid) / Start of 60's Sexual Revolution.
1962	Vatican II convened by Pope John XXIII. Closed in 1965
1968	Humanae Vitae issued by Pope Paul VI, dashing prior expectations.
1973	Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton, Supreme Court decisions. Radical feminism says "This is my body"
2010	(March) "Seriously Flawed Health Care" (USCCB term) passes with pork barrel politics at its worst
2012	Health and Human Services (HHS) Mandate for health care providers to include contraceptives, sterilization and abortion at \$1 per month per person. This charge will not be itemized so that it would be hard for individuals to see the charge.

Our Church says children and marriage belong together. Contraception dissolves the unitive and procreative aspects of marriage.

The unintended consequences of acceptance of contraception include: Rise in divorce*, General lowering of moral standards*, Abortion, Sterilization, Same sex union, Pedophilia / Child Trafficking, HHS "Severely Flawed" healthcare* and Micro-abortions caused by oral contraceptives.

* Three predictions of Humanae Vitae

When good people do not oppose evil, evil runs rampant. Philosophical and Theological underpinnings of Humanae Vitae were the body of material used by Pope John Paul II in his 179 general weekly audiences "Theology of the Body", from 1979 to 1984. In the future I would like to study Theology of the Body on the 3rd Wednesday of the Month so that Knights and their families will both know what the Religious Liberty is asking for and to desire it.

The timeline gives an idea how this "one little error" ties into an integrated whole. "This is my body" is both why we need to be redeemed by Christ and is also the key to our redemption.

Immediately, we have the continuation of an urgent action, to get signatures to support the bills in the House and Senate (HR 1179 and S 1467). This action is what the USCCB and Former State Deputy Laake have indicated as the best plan of attack. Even if the Supreme Court rules in favor of Religious Freedom, we need this locked down in law, to ward off future changes in interpretation. I ask each of you to return at least one form to my address below. You do not need to have 17 signatures, but please get as many as you can. While this recovers some effort, it is an effective way we can defend our religious liberty for our future generations.
