GRAND KNIGHT'S MESSAGE

Lent has arrived and I am sure that most of you are working on items to prepare you and your families for this period in our Churches' calendar and eventually to Easter. Like Advent we again as Christians and Knights prepare the way for Our Lord, similar to what St John the Baptist had proclaimed to the coming of our Lord. Just maybe go outside your comfort zone to either aide, help or do something during this time as a reflection of this period in our current Church calendar. This could be going to church more than on Sunday, saying the rosary daily, fasting 1 day a week and donating the cost of the food you would have purchased to one of several charity organizations in our metro area. Another idea would be to donate a can or nonperishable item to a local food pantry such as the Metro Catholic Outreach, Marion Food Pantry, or St Vincent De Paul for the 40 days in Lent - so that could be 40 items.

On another front, I want you to keep in your prayers the fact that by the time this comes out we may have two Popes in our world. One, Pope Benedict, who is retiring at the end of February and our New Pope which will be named by the college of Cardinals sometime in early March. We need to keep this process in our prayers to insure that God, through them, inspires them to elect a Pope who can continue the work that Benedict left unfinished.

I have read in the local paper that the Catholic Bishops in Iowa have asked the State to introduce a voucher program in the state. This would give families the availability for Federal Vouchers via a grant program that they can use to pay for private education. Not only would it include religious schools (Catholic, Christian) but also private schools and some charter schools. Now I know that would be a great option for families who have sent their children to public schools due to the affordability factor. With this program they would have an option to choose, which may not be available now.

The gala celebration of our council's 50 anniversary is scheduled for Saturday, March 9th, and starts with Mass at 4 pm at our hall to be followed by adult beverages and a banquet with many surprises. I hope you will consider coming to this historic event of our council. Tickets may be purchased at the door on the day of the event, however please let us know if you plan to attend, so we can give the proper numbers to our caterer.

CULTURE OF LIFE ACTIVITY

The US Conference of Catholic Bishops has asked us to advance a movement for Life, Marriage, and Religious Liberty through prayer, penance and sacrifice.
