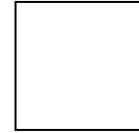

LENTEN FISH FRY RESULTS NEXT FISH FRY APRIL 15TH

The weatherman's threat of a blizzard (which didn't occur) and not advertised in the Gazette the first week resulted in only 364 paying customers at our first Lenten Fish Fry. Mild weather the next five weeks brought in crowds of 464, 528, 488, 456 and 474.

2,774 paying adults and teens attended. That figure does not include the 5 - 10 year olds who eat a reduced price or those under 5 who eat free. Also not included are our priests and religious and our KC widows who always eat free. Volunteers preparing the food on Thursday and those working the fish fry add another 80 meals. Any food left over is taken to groups serving meals to the needy.

Thanks to all who worked a shift or two or more during our Lenten Fish Fries. As in the past, \$1,000 will be given to St. Joe's, St. Pius and St. Elizabeth for their youth programs.

As I have mentioned in the past, I try to give all able bodied KC's as well as their wives, teens and guests the opportunity to join us in this worthwhile and enjoyable project. Landlines are being dropped and I don't have current cell phone numbers to call.
