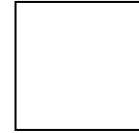

## **KC HALL RENTAL FEE INFORMATION**

The KC Hall is available for wedding receptions, anniversaries, birthday parties, Christmas parties, luncheons, etc. The following chart outlines our rental fee guidelines. As members of Council 5390, we receive some nice discounts on rental fees. We also get discounts on bar items.

### Rental fees:

Friday: non - members: \$450; members: \$100.  
Saturday: non - members: \$500; members: \$300.  
Sunday: non - members: \$400; members: \$100.  
Monday:- Thursday:  
non - members: \$50 per hour, 2 hour minimum;  
members: \$50 flat rate.

Cost for a member using the hall for a special anniversary 25 years or more: free any day (limit to one per month).

The special member rates apply only to Council 5390 members and their immediate family members. Because of the nice discounts we receive as members, we are asked to help with set up and clean up.
