LENT & THE DEVOUT LIFE

A few years ago, I helped Rosemary and her sister clean out their parents' house. My in-laws, especially my Mother-in-law enjoyed books. The task of organizing them for the family to review fell to me. In the end I had the entire living room filled with them. In the process I "inherited" quite a number of spiritual books, which affirmed for me how important their faith was to them, especially my Father-in-law. In part it was his witness to the Catholic faith and how he 'lived' it that drew me to the Diaconate.

One of the many books I hauled home is St. Francis de Sales, Introduction to the Devout Life. St. Francis wrote it especially for the laity of all walks of life. To this end he said: *"It is an error...to say devotion is incompatible with the life of a soldier, a tradesman, a prince, or a married woman.... It has happened that many have lost perfection in the desert who had preserved it in the world."*

Pope Pius XI, in 1922, urged all the faithful to read the *Devout Life*. While this may have served some inspiration, also at the urgings of others (not to discount the promptings of the Holy Spirit) I recently decided to read it. I found it to be a quite readable and understandable book.

The harsh winter we are experiencing has many folks down, perhaps feeling some anguish and understandably hoping for an early spring. On sadness St Francis wrote that it: *"...disturbs the heart, plunges it into anxiety...deprives it of courage and crushes its strength. It is like a hard winter which withers the beauty of the earth and numbs all life, for it deprives the soul of sweetness"*.

Ash Wednesday is March 6, the beginning of Lent. The 'desert' (winter) of Lent and its days of preparation lead into the warmer days of Spring and the glories of Easter. Have you thought about what you will do during this time of spiritual preparation, to open your heart to God's graces? Almsgiving - Do to others as you would have them do to you (see Luke 6:31, the gospel for the 7th Sunday of Ordinary Time). *"Prayer is the remedy for sadness, it raises the soul to God, who is our joy"* (de Sales). Consider doing so with our Lord at Eucharistic Adoration. Fasting - Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fast. Perhaps you will be inspired to do some spiritual reading. If not *The Devout Life*, feel free to contact me for other suggestions.

Lent is a journey of renewal; a time to repent of sinful inclinations and reform our lives. It is also an opportunity to develop new habits, that not only change our lives but that can also be carried over into our everyday lives as well. This Lent let us separate ourselves from some of the material things of our lives. To humbly put the needs of others before our own needs. And through this focus we can enrich our spiritual life, allowing the grace and mercy of God to change our lives; renew our hearts and restore the sweetness of our souls. *Let us pray that the Lord create us anew, a spirit that enables us to accept change in our lives for your greater glory.*
